TROPHY EVENTS

- ∞ Margaret Baulch Trophy (Ev 31) awarded to the winning team of the 10 & under Mixed 4x50m relay.
- ∞ Friendship Relays (Ev 29, Ev 30) are of historical significance to DRDSA first commencing in 1960.
- The David Cook Memorial Trophy (Ev 27, Ev 28) awarded to the champion Male and Female 200IM swimmer in memory of David Cook, a respected member of the swimming community and Life Member of both Metro East and Swimming Victoria.

All clubs compete for the honour of winning the McArthur Trophy to become the District Champion Club. This trophy is named after Mr & Mrs McArthur for their 16 years of untiring effort as President and Secretary of DRDSA from 1960.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- o To be conducted under the rules of Swimming Australia Ltd and Swimming Victoria Inc.
- Entry is subject to acceptance of the Swimming Victoria Covid-19 Terms & Conditions for Entry & Attendance at Competitions, published in Swim Central and on the Metro East website event page
- o This meet is open only to registered competitive swimmer members of a Metro East affiliated Club.
- A proposed qualifying meet.
- o All events will be swum as timed finals. Semi-Automatic Timing will be used
- o Pool depths: shallow end: 1.0 meters; deep end: 1.9 meters. Pool length is 50 meters
- Metro East will not be enforcing the 11 & under SV swim suit policy for this meet
- Age as at 17th March 2024.

ENTRY METHODS

- Swim Central entries only will be accepted.
- EVENT ENTRY FEE: \$11.00 per individual event (including \$1.25 SV Approved Meet Levy).
- o Entries close Sunday 10th March 2024 or earlier if capacity reached.
- o Refund of entry fees will only be provided if the entry is rejected.
- RELAY ENTRIES \$20 per relay

ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

- To be eligible for medals a swimmer must have competed in at least two district events in the 2023-24 season. This can be any two of Junior District Trials, Distance Competition, Long Course Preparation Meet, All Junior Trials. Or, any one of the above plus one meet run as an open qualifying meet (short or long course) by a district club (eg. Nunawading, MLC, Ringwood, Surrey Park). Swimmers who have not met the above criteria are welcome to enter and swim but will be deemed an exhibition swimmer. They will not be eligible to receive individual medals but they can compete in relays.
- Swimmers, including MC, who have a current National Qualifying Time for their age group as of 10th March 2024 are not eligible to enter individual events in the stroke (irrespective of distance) they have the National Qualifying Time for without the express permission of the Metro East Competitions Team. Nationally qualified swimmers wishing to enter please contact east.meets@hotmail.com prior to entering. Entries will only be granted if space permits and at the discretion of the Competitions Team and such entries will be marked as 'exhibition' and therefore ineligible for medals or placings.
- The Open 200m Individual Medley events (David Cook Trophy) are open to all swimmers including those who have National Qualifying Times.

AWARDING OF MEDALS

- Medals will be awarded for 1st 2nd & 3rd places in both 'A' & 'B' grades in individual events, as the Competitions Committee deems appropriate.
- o Swimmers entered with "NO TIME" are not eligible for either 'A' OR 'B' Grade medals.
- NOTE: Swimmers who do not have an entry time in the Swim Central database, rather than ending up being entered
 as NT, should email a coaches verified entry time to east.meets@hotmail.com before 10th March 2024. Times
 received after this date will not be accepted.

EXTRACT "GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION OF DISTRICT TEAM"

- o Swimmers must have turned 12 years by June 2024 to be considered for selection.
- Age Group "A" grade medalists will be considered. Accordingly, Swimmers who want to be considered for the District Trip should ensure they enter the 100m events in their age group.
- NOTE: Nationally qualified swimmers in any event/distance at the time of District Championships WILL NOT be considered.
